IMPORTANT NOTES ON PARKING

GREAT MISSENDEN

There is limited parking close to the Oldham Hall where lunch is being served, with much more parking available at the Church. Street parking by the Hall is a mixture of residents only and time limited bays so it is suggested that people who are fit to do so park at the Church and walk down to the Hall (about 350 yards) before walking back for the service and meeting.

The Church parking can be accessed either through the village via Church Street or directly from the B485 Frith Hill/Chesham Road. If entering from the B485 please take care as the entrance drops and turns sharply away from the main road.

A shuttle service will operate between the Hall and the Church for anyone who cannot easily walk between the two venues.

If you do not want to risk being blocked in at the Hall or the Church then use either of the public car parks (fee payable) at Buryfield on Link Road and take the footpath from the Buryfield car park to reach Oldham Hall (4 minute walk). These are also the preferred car parks if you are intending to visit the Roald Dahl museum in the village high street from which it is less than 10 minutes' walk to the Church.

HADDENHAM

Parking in surrounding streets. Toilet in church.

MONKS RISBOROUGH

Street parking in Mill Lane. No parking in Burton Lane. From Mill Lane the church is accessed via Burton Lane or by the footpath that runs between a playing field and the churchyard. Refreshments and toilet facilities available in the church hall which is in the churchyard, near the church porch.

ELLESBOROUGH

Car park on opposite side of road to the Church (through the gate on left). Portaloo located in Church car park. **Take care crossing the road.** Refreshments available.

WENDOVER

Church car park at end of the lane round the back of the church or street parking. Toilet and refreshments available in church.

LANE END

Parking on the green outside the church. Toilet in churchyard. Refreshments available in church.

BEACONSFIELD

Allow time to find street parking (plenty available in surrounding streets but they are usually very busy). Toilet in adjacent Fitzwilliams Centre.

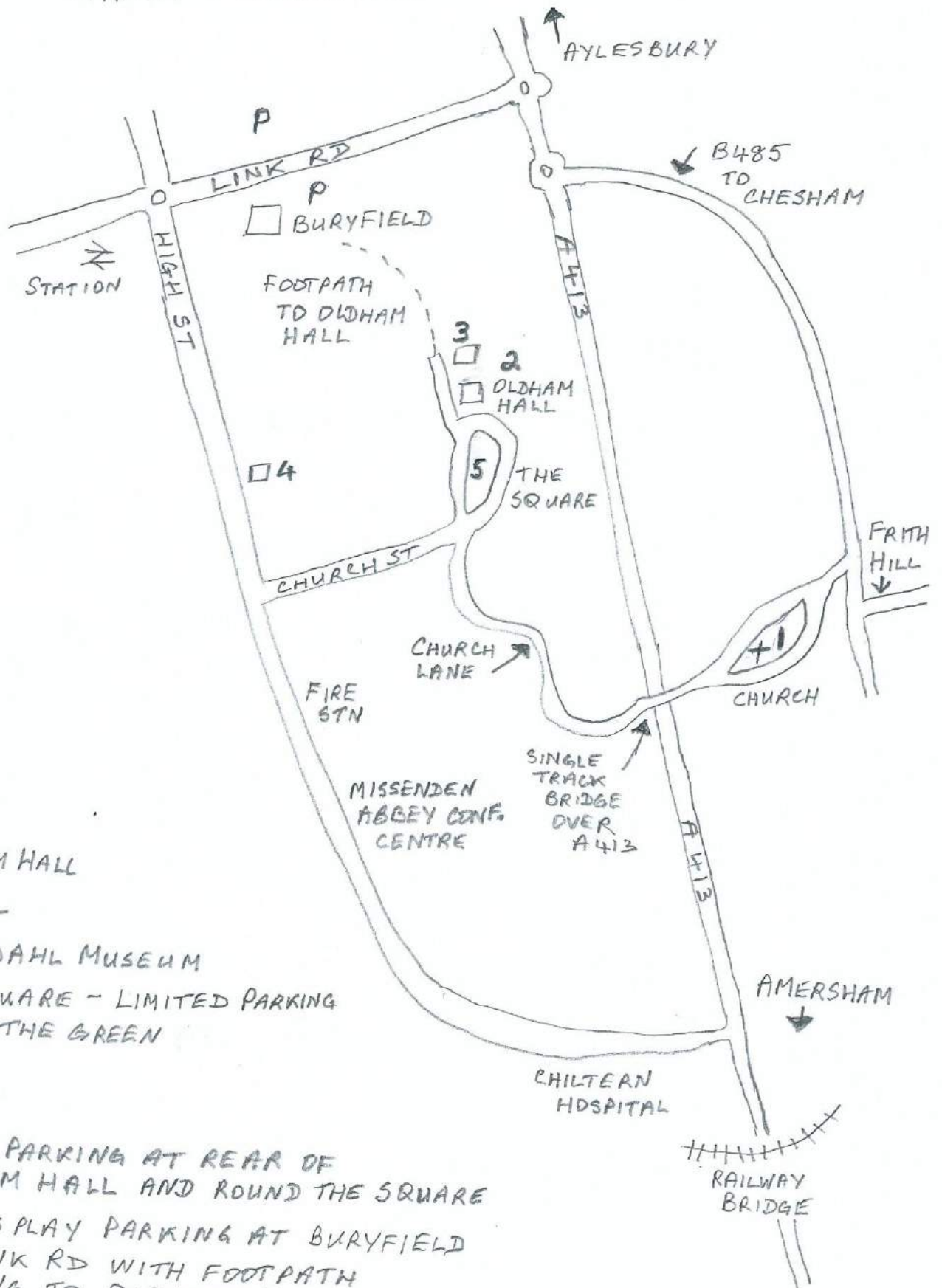
PENN

Parking at church hall on opposite side of road to the church. Toilet in church hall. Refreshments available in church.

AMERSHAM

Allow time to find street parking or public car park. **NO PARKING AT CHURCH.** Toilets in church and also in the pay and display car park a short walk from the church or at Tesco's a short walk/drive away on the A413 (London direction). The award winning Amersham in Bloom Memorial Gardens beside the church are well worth a visit.

PARKING

- LIMITED PARKING AT REAR OF OLDHAM HALL AND ROUND THE SQUARE
- PAY + DISPLAY PARKING AT BURYFIELD ON LINK RD WITH FOOTPATH LEADING TO OLDHAM HALL
- PARKING AT CHURCH ACCESSED FROM CHURCH LANE OR THE B485 TO CHESHAM. SHUTTLE AVAILABLE BETWEEN CHURCH & HALL.
- DISABLED PARKING AT CHURCH ACCESSED BY CHURCH LANE
- NO PARKING ON CHURCH LANE (EXCEPT IN MARKED BAYS). BRIDGE OVER A413 TO CHURCH IS SINGLE TRACK, NO PARKING ON BRIDGE
