## About this course:

Suitable for those who already teach bell handling and want to update their skills AND for those who have never taught anyone to handle a bell. Module 1 provides you with the skills and techniques necessary to take a ringer from their first lesson to having competent bell control.

The practical sessions will give you plenty of time to practise your new skills in a safe environment. Working in pairs you will also have opportunity to hone your observation skills

and get feedback on your feedback.

After the course it is important that those who attend should get practice at teaching ringing with a mentor present to help them to observe and to help them remember the important points.
